The 49th Regiment Tennessee Infantry was organized December 24, 1861. It was captured at Ft. Donelson, Tenn., February 16, 1862; released at Vicksburg, Miss., September 20, 1862; re-organized September 27, 1862; and declared exchanged at Aiken's Landing, Va., November 10, 1862. It was temporarily consolidated with the 55th (Brown's) Regiment Tennessee Infantry and the 7th Regiment Texas Infantry from October, 1862, to January, 1863, and formed Bailey's Consolidated Regiment Confederate Infantry. In March, 1865, the 42d, 46th, 48th, 49th, 53d and 55th Regiments Tennessee Infantry were consolidated into one field organization.

*This company was also known as Company D, Bailey's Consolidated Regiment of Infantry. It was formed by the consolidation of Companies B and L, 49th Regiment Tennessee Infantry.

Bailey's Consolidated Regiment of Infantry was a temporary field organization which was formed in October, 1862, by order of Gen. Tilghman and consisted of eleven companies, A to L. Companies A and B were composed of a remnant of the 7th Regiment Texas Infantry; Companies C to G and L consisted of members of the 49th Regiment Tennessee Infantry, and Companies H, I and K were formed of men who belonged to the 55th (Brown's) Regiment Tennessee Infantry. The organization appears to have been broken up in January or February, 1863, and the men returned to their former commands.

The 49th Regiment Tennessee Infantry was organized December 24, 1861. It was captured at Ft. Donelson, Tenn., February 16, 1862; released at Vicksburg, Miss., September 20, 1862; re-organized September 27, 1862; and declared exchanged at Aiken's Landing, Va., November 10, 1862. It was temporarily consolidated with the 55th (Brown's) Regiment Tennessee Infantry and the 7th Regiment Texas Infantry from October, 1862, to January, 1863, and formed Bailey's Consolidated Regiment Confederate Infantry. In March, 1865, the 42d, 46th, 48th, 49th, 52d and 55th Regiments Tennessee Infantry were consolidated into one field organization.

forty ninth Regiment of *Tennessee Volunteers*, born in *Cathlamet County* in the State of
North Carolina, aged *forty* years, *five* feet, *ten* inches high, *light* complexion,
Blue eyes, *light* hair, and by *occupation a Farmer*, was enlisted by
Capt. J. A. Taylor at *Chalklevel Benton Co Tenn* on the *seventh* day of
November 186*1*, to serve *one* years, and is now entitled to discharge by reason of
sickness and unfit for the service

The said *C. C. Mitchell* was last paid by *Major J. W. Jones*
 to include the *thirty first* day of *July* 186*2*, and has pay due from that time to the present date.
 There is due him *100* Dollars traveling allowance from *the place of discharge, to the place of enrollment,*
 transportation not being furnished in kind.

There is due him *Sixty seven dollars 10 cent*
 there is due him *forty dollars and 48/100* for clothing
 not drawn in kind
