(continued) he appl 30 Aug 1832 & sol d there 31 Aug 1837, sol had m 16 Jun 1787 to Alies or Alice Parker & she was b 1 Aug 1769, wid appl 1 Sep 1838 at Hocksett NH, on 23 Apr 1855 she was living in Manchester NH, wid d 5 May 1855, children were; James b 25 Nvo 1788, Abraham b 19 Aug 1790, Nathaniel b 24 Apr 1793 & d 10 Oct 1819, Benjamin b 23 Jul 1795, Joseph b 30 Jul 1797, Retyre b 23 Sep 1799, Abigail b 6 Jan 1802, Aria b 7 Jan 1804 & Peter b 1 Oct 1808

MITCHELL, Nathaniel, S9418, PA Line, sol lived in Franklin Co PA at enl & in 1814 he moved to Washington Co PA where he appl 20 Oct 1835 aged 86 a res of Donegal Twnshp PA, a son was living in 1836, no name Nathaniel, Nancy, W3850, PA Line, sol appl 29 Apr 1818 Washington Co OH aged 78, in 1820 sol stated his children were all of aged with the youngest being the age of 22 & that he had a grandson aged 56 but did not give any names, sol had m Nancy Stephenson 27 Dec 1782, sol d 20 May 1836, wid appl 7 Jan 1839 Washington Co OH aged 73, in 1843 she was living in Olive Twnshp in Morgan Co OH

Nazareth, S8897, NC Line, sol was b in 1758 in Northampton Co NC & he lived in Franklin Co NC at enl, he appl 27 Nov 1832 in Robeson Co NC

Reaps or Reaps Michell, BLW #2335-100, VA Line, VA State BLW #6338 for 1166 2/3 acres was issued to 15 Sep 1819 to Benjamin Turner the exc'r of sol's will in which sol named the following, a wife Susanna & children; John & Paul Mitchell, Martha Turner, Thomas Branch Mitchell, Henry & Peggy Mitchell, the will was witnessed by Wm. Rives, Jones Mitchell, James Hobbs & Miles Turner & was presented to the court on 11 Aug 1803 at which time sol was dec'd, sol's daughter Martha Turner made aff'dt 17 Mar 1844 in Sussex Co VA & Henry Turner & Wm. Thornton were witnesses to her aff'dt, on 10 Jun 1844 it was stated that Benjamin Turner the husband of Martha (Mitchell) Turner was dec'd & that "Paugh" Mitchell (as written) was dec'd & sol's sons Thomas B. & Henry had not been heard from in many yrs & sol's only surviving children in 1844 were Martha Turner & Peggy wife of Wm. Elder

Reuben, Ann, W5373, GA Line, sol enl in Mecklenburg Co VA & soon after the Rev he moved to NC, he appl 10 Sep 1818 Chatham Co NC & was still there in 1822, sol m Ann Pennington of Mecklenburg Co VA on 2 Apr 1781 & she stated her mother (not named) was an own cousin of Gen'l George Washington, sol d 11 Feb 1826, wid appl 20 Jul 1841 Chatham Co NC aged 77 & stated she had lived there for 53 yrs & she d there 4 Sep 1843, children were; Ned b 2 Jun 1784 & in 1841 had been dead many yrs, Lucy b 24 Feb 1786 Sarah or Sary or Sally b 12 Feb 1790, Benjamin b 11 Jul 1792, Henry b 1 Mar 1794 & in 1848 was living in Chatham Co NC & Rheuben or Reuben b 24 May 1798 or 1799 (both dates given) & all the children except Ned survived their mother, in 1818 a Robert Pennington made aff'dt in NC but no relationship to wid was given, also shown was --?--n Mitchell b Mar 1816 (part torn off record)

Reuben, Anna, W26265, MA Line, sol appl 6 Mar 1833 Berkshire Co MA aged 75, wid appl 30 Sep 1836 Berkshire Co MA aged 79, sol & wid had m 23 Oct 1783 at Bridgewater in Plymouth Co MA, sol d at Lenox MA on 14 Feb 1835, sol's sis Betty Mitchell of North Bridgewater MA a single woman aged 77 in Mar 1836 made aff'dt & stated sol moved from Bridgewater MA in 1792-3 with his wife & 2 children to the western part of MA & that her bro had m Anna Wade at the home of her father James Wade in Bridgewater MA

Richard, BLW #11520-100-11 Mar 1791, srv as a Pvt in the MD Line

Richard, S16964, MA Line, appl 1 Aug 1832 Cumberland Co ME aged 74 a res of Minot ME

Richard, S1234, VA Line, sol was b 12 Aug 1762 in Culpeper Co VA & he lived in Spotsylvania Co VA at enl & in the summer of 1781 he moved to Caroline Co VA & also enl there, he appl 8 Apr 1833 in Fayette Co KY

Robert, Mary, W15083, MA Line, sol was of Scarborough MA (ME) when he m Mary (--) of Falmouth MA (ME) 5 Nov 1778, sol d 3 Feb 1820, wid appl 2 Mar 1844 Cumberland Co ME aged 84 a res of Portland ME

Robert, BLW #9996-100-9 May 1791, srv as a Pvt in the PA Line

Robert, Letitia, W3441, VA Line, sol enl in Lunenburg Co VA, he appl 12 Apr 1819 Charlotte Co VA & in 1829 he was aged 72 & had returned to Lunenburg Co VA where he d 30 Dec 1846, sol had m Letitia or Letty Ren on 25 Dec 1788 at the home of her father William Ren, Sr. in Lunenburg Co VA & his wid appl there 4 Sep 1847 aged 70, sol & wife had a large family & in 1829 sol referred to sons (not named)

Robert, Eve, W7459, VA Line, sol was b 6 Sep 1741, he lived at Winchester in Frederick Co VA at enl & ih 1790 he moved to Warm Springs VA for several yrs & in 1811 he was living at Morrystown in Belmont Co OH where he appl 10 Apr 1818 & he was still there in 1823 but in 1826 he had moved to Ohio Co VA, sol m Eve (--) in Jul 1773 at Winchester VA & they were m by a Lutheran minister a Rev. Mr. Mitchell, sol d in Jun 1827, wid appl 29 Jan 1839 Belmont Co OH aged 84 & she was there in 1848, sol & wife had several children but only a daughter Mary Bramshall who had m in 1803 & in 1839 was aged about 55 a res of Belmont Co OH was named in the claim

Rotheas, Hepzibah, W17168, MA Line, sol m Hepzibah "Hepza" Hayward 3 Apr 1783 both were of Bridgewater MA, wid appl 18 Sep 1838 St. Lawrence Co NY aged 76 on 8 Aug 1838, sol d 29 Oct 1816, wid stated her father was Acselk Josiah "Hayford" & that she was b 8 Aug 1769 at S. Bridgeater & afterwards her father moved to E. Bridgewater where sol & wid lived for 10 yrs after their m then moved to Lime NH where sol died & in Mar 1836 sol's wid moved to Parishville in St. Lawrence Co NY with her oldest son Horatio Mitchell with whom she lived, sol's & wid's children were; Syntha b 5 Jan 1784 & she m Isaac Hobart & in 1848 she was of Parishville NY, Eliphalet b 17 Nov 1785, Horatio b 17 Dec 1787 & in 1848 was of Parishville NY, Betsey b 25 May 1791, Abiel b 27 Jul 1793 & in 1848 was of Pottsdam NY, Anna b 24 Jul 1795 & she m Silas Chapman of Stockholm NY & was living in 1848, Marcus b 12 Jan 1797 & in 1848 was of Parishville NY (his name also shown as Marcus H.), William b 19 Mar 1799, Barzilla b 25 Oct 1801, Luther b 25 Aug 1804 & Nathan b 1 Sep 1806, sol's wid d at Parishville NY on 9 Jun 1848, this data was sent to a Mr. R.H. Mitchell of Nevada in Story Co IA by the pension bureau on 18 Apr 1885

Samuel or Samuel Micall, Catharine, W10512, BLW #729-100 & BLW #225-60-55, MA Line & War of 1812 Srv, sol m Catharine Gray 27 Jul 1842 both were of Litchfield in Kennebec Co ME, sol was b at Wells MA (ME) & he appl 30 Mar 1818 at Augusta MA (ME) aged 56, in 1820 sol's wife Mary was aged 69, sol reapplied 27 Oct 1834 at Bowdoin in Lincoln Co ME where he lived for 1 yr & prior to that had lived at Lisbon ME for 3 or 4 yrs, wid appl 28 Jun 1853 at Litchfield ME aged 68 & sol had d there 12 Nov 1852 & his wid also appl there for BLW 9 May 1855 & an Eliza Gray was a witness to her 1855 aff'dt

Samuel, BLW #852-100-14 Feb 1820, NY Line, on 4 Feb 1820 sol's only surviving heir Martin Mitchel of Amenia in Dutches Co NY signed p.o.a., sol was a son of Patrick Mitchel, on 30 Aug 1819 (cont next pg)
