To any Person Authorized by Law, or any Justice of the Peace of said County—GREETING:

You, or Either of You, are hereby authorized to solemnize the RITE OF MATRIMONY between J. F. Boyd and Susie O'Doniley of our County, agreeably to the direction of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided: Provided, always, that the Rite of Matrimony be solemnized in this County; otherwise these shall be null and void, and shall not be accounted any License or authority to you, or either of you, for the purpose aforesaid, more than though the same had never been prayed or granted, etc.
