

Last will & Testament of John Norwood

Forrest County, District of Columbia
 Oct. Term 1857

I John Norwood a citizen of Forrest County, Tenn do make and publish this my last will and Testament - hereby revoking all Wills by me at any time here before made

1st I direct that - after my death - and funeral expenses be paid - as soon after my death as possible - out of any money - that I may die possessed of - or that may come into the hands of my executor - for any portion of my estate either real or personal

2nd I give and bequeath - unto my wife Matilda Norwood all of my property - both real, personal and mixed - to have and to occupy the same in any manner - she thinks proper for and during her Natural life - or widowhood

3rd I give unto my son J. W. Norwood a piece of Land in the State of Arkansas and Kansas County - containing -- 80 Acres - the tract of Land that he J. W. Norwood now lives on

4th After the death or marriage of my wife I will all of my property - that may remain to be divided equally among my children - and grand children - except my son F. J. Norwood and his children - according to the laws of descent and distribution now in force in Tennessee -

5th I give unto my son F. J. Norwood or his heirs the Dallas Co. his portion

Lastly I hereby make nominal and appoint my wife Matilda Norwood Executor of this my last will and Testament - and having full confidence in her honesty and integrity - I hereby excuse her from giving any bond for the faithful execution of the aforesaid Trust - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this October 30 1850

 my last will & testament, hereby revoking all

 by me.

First, I do will and desire in that form and after
 my decease, my beloved wife, Emily Dickey, to
 have and to hold unto her, her heirs and assigns forever,
 James O. Dickey and Iden M. Dickey have the
 portion and jointly and equally of all the land
 and property arising from the Homestead place
 where I now reside, which is described as follows:
 viz: The north half of the north-east quarter, the
 north half of the north-west quarter, the south
 half of the north-east quarter, the south-east
 quarter of the north-west quarter, and the north
 half of the north-east quarter of the south-east
 quarter. All in Section one (1) in Township Ten
 (10) North of range twenty-eight (28) west of the
