January 11th, 1863.

DEAR SIR:—Will you be kind enough to publish in your columns, the following list of killed, wounded and missing, in the 4th Arkansas regiment, in the late battle of Murfreesboro, Tennessee, viz:

*Field and Staff, none.*

Company A, Lieut T A Thornton, commanding. Killed—Sergt. R J Ware; slightly wounded—color bearer, John B Bryant; corporals Mathew Hardon, and John Carr; privates W M Weatherly, John Sittimon, M Johnson, and D M Misinger. Missing—sergt S A Smith.

Company B, Capt H J Bonner, commanding. Killed—private W S Fuller; severely wounded, privates N Adams, and W M Brown, W R Norwood, slightly wounded; sergt. R H Davis; privates, J P Grader, and R W Boyce; missing—corporal W B Gibson.
